INVITATION

The VÖAV organizes, under the Patronage of the FIAP Youth Service, the 35th Youth Biennial of FIAP in 2013 and invites young authors of all countries, member of FIAP, to participate in this Youth contest.

CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Each national association member of FIAP may enter 20 digital works (max. 1 work per author) per age category. The judgement will be carried out in two age categories.

I. up to the age of 16 years (born after 31.08.1997)

II. up to the age of 21 years (born after 31.08.1992)

The pictures will have to be sent in JPG format via Windows their longest side must be 1024 pixels, with a resolution, up to 72 dpi, both for black and white and colour images.

WORK SIZE

Files will be JPG 8 compressed, 72dpi, height 800 pixels maxi, with 1024 pixels maxi. Files will be named with the country name followed by a number 01 to 20 (example: AUSTRIA 01.jpg, AUSTRIA 02.jpg, etc.) and will be stored in a directory "Jury". And other directory "Catalogue" will contain the same images high definition (300 dpi, 2400 pixels for the larger side).

The images entered in the competition will be sent as electronic material (CD, DVD, Zip Cartridges etc.) by mail, or e-mail using <https://www.wetransfer.com>, together with the entry form and entry fees (payment documentation).

The entrant must own the copyright of the submitted works. All parts of the picture must be photographed by the author.

JUDGEMENT

The works in each of the two age categories will be judged separately by a renowned jury. The judgement will be carried out according to the instructions of FIAP, with no right of appeal.

PRIZES

The Biennial for each age category, will be awarded as follows:

Digital World Cup for the best national federation.

FIAP Gold medal for the federation which comes second.

FIAP Silver medal, for the federation which comes third.

FIAP Bronze medal for the federation which comes fourth.

FIAP diplomas for the federations which come 5th to 7th.

All the authors of the federation coming first receive an honourable mention.

One FIAP gold, one silver and one bronze medal will award works of exceptional quality, independently of the federations' classification.

Each author can only receive one prize.

Additionally, the organizing country may award national prizes, prizes of the jury or special prizes and diplomas.

CATALOGUE

The catalogue will be produced on CD-Rom, with all awarded works and a wide selection of the participating works, along side the list of all the works per country and the list of award-winning authors. (The CD will be produced with a programme allowing it to work with no difficulty).

The CD will show on the cover the FIAP logo with the relative Biennial number. On the CD all the compulsory statistics about the salon must be recorded.

The author agrees that his works may be published on a CD-Rom catalogue and on an Internet WEB page free of charge. The works will not be used in a commercial context. There is no possibility of recourse to legal action.
